RULES

Pre-registration is REQUIRED 21 days prior to show. To register, complete entry form. This will allow for better cage utilization

1. Exhibitor must complete registration card to include name, address and social Security number to get a check.
2. Individuals will be allowed to make 1 entry in each class, provided coops are available. If only one entry is made in a class, this entry will be judged for prize money and ribbons if qualifying under standard of perfection, it will not be given first prize automatically, but will be placed where the judge feels it should be.
3. All chain birds must be kept and cared for at exhibitor’s residence and there will be no splitting of batches.
4. Entries in all classes except A-1 and A-2 shall meet the requirements of the American Standard of Perfection.
5. No birds can be re-arranged in any manner after entry into the poultry building.
6. All chain broilers will be banded at 1 day of age and must have original band still on the birds when entered into the show.

4-H Sponsored Program

These spring day-old white leghorn and Golden Sex Link pullets were placed with the pullet chain participants in the county. Each member agreed to feed and care for the pullets under the supervision of the Cooperative Extension Service and return 4 out of each 25 pullets to the Washington County 4-H Foundation at the country fair. They will be sold and the money will be used to buy chicks the following year. All of the pullets have been vaccinated throughout the growing period and are just coming into production.

All chain birds must be kept and cared for at exhibitor’s residence and there will be no sharing of batches.

The participants are to return top quality pullets, no culls accepted and they must be in place at the fairgrounds by 9:00pm Monday August 29th.
