### **RULES**

In addition to the general adult or junior home economics department rules:

1. Junior ages is 1 through 19 years old.
2. Entries must be entered on Monday of the fair for judging Monday Night.
3. All entries must be grown by the exhibitor.
4. Only one entry per class per exhibitor
5. Potted plants with a drain hole **MUST HAVE A SAUCER.**
6. No pot larger than 12" in diameter across the top or 30" in overall height. Exception: Class #8, Class #11, and Class #19.
7. Only one class of plant per pot. Exception: Class #5 and Class #11.
8. Container shall be judged as part of the exhibit.
9. Exhibitors must furnish the name of the potted plants at entry.
10. All hanging baskets must be equipped with a ring and a hook for hanging
11. Total length of hanging basket and plant must not exceed 5 feet.
12. Plants will be watered by fair officials. However, exhibitor may come in any time after judging to freshen up or add water.
13. Pick Up time: Saturday 8:30pm to 9:00pm. See page 6 for pickup schedule. Sunday 12 noon to 3:00pm. Fair not responsible for containers and plants left after 3pm Sunday.
