RULES FOR GRADE ID DAIRY CATTLE

1. This year there will be three grade ID dairy heifers selected for the Junior Livestock Sale. However, there must be at least five grade ID heifers present for the sale order selection, otherwise, no grade heifers will sell.
2. The grade ID cattle must be purebred dairy animals. Crossbred grade ID cattle will not be allowed to show nor be in the sale.
3. The grade ID cattle must be representative of the breed and must be approved by the Junior Superintendent.
