



WCF JUNIOR LIVESTOCK DEPARTMENTS GENERAL RULES

DAIRY, BEEF, SHEEP, SWINE, DAIRY GOATS, MEAT GOATS.

Exhibitors, Please Read & Observe

1. All general and open livestock show rules apply except grade dairy cows and heifers may be shown. Grade dairy animals must be purebred or appear purebred. No beef cross animals will be allowed, except in commercial beef classes.
2. Adults are not permitted to show an animal for exhibitors in the Junior Department.
3. Animals entered in the market classes shall be weighed and identified as directed by the superintendents.
4. Exhibitors may exhibit in this department no later than the fall after graduating from high school.
5. Jr. breeding animals will be judged on Danish systems with no more than 5 blue ribbons to be given per class.
6. All Market Hogs must be ear tagged (market hogs ONLY) prior to June 23, arrangements must be made by contacting Greg & Alta Davis at 267.3949. No hogs can be ear tagged after that date.
7. Duties of a Ring Stewart
 - a. To keep animals in order by weight or age to aid the judge in evaluation.
 - b. To assist exhibitors with unruly or immobile animals to insure a safe, orderly show.
 - c. To see that the judges instructions are followed by the exhibitors.
 - d. To assist exhibitors in catching and regaining control of an animal.
 - e. To assist the judge if he decides an animal should be tied to the rail or excused from the ring.
8. Junior breeding stock placing 1st or 2nd in their class may show in the Open Division, if there is competition, for ½ the premium.
9. All Market Steers must be ear tagged by Junior Beef Superintendent prior to June 23.
10. All sheep must have premise I.D. tag before entering fairground.
11. Meat Goats must be tagged 60 days prior to fair.
12. Must pre-register livestock by August 1, 2011 to receive car pass.

All showmanship contestants must own their animal or immediate family member own the animal and they must sign the release/hold harmless form obtained from the division superintendent.
